

Advisory Visit Guidance

The purpose of an Advisory Visit is to offer advice and guidance to Centres about specific Skills and Education Group Awards qualification/s. This is a bespoke visit and should take no more than 4 hours.

The Centre should set the agenda for the visit themselves in order to get the most out of it. This will ensure that all of their questions are answered and will leave Centres feeling confident in delivering Skills and Education Group Awards qualifications.

An Advisory Visit will incur a cost of £300 for a 4 hour visit, which will include a formal report summarising what was covered within the visit along with any recommendations moving forward. A Skills and Education Group Awards representative will then pick this up and support the Centre moving forward.
