

Awarding in Spring and Summer 2021: Guidance for Centres

Background

1. This document outlines the process for awarding learners under the Vocational and Technical Qualifications Continuity Regulatory Framework ('VCRF'). This may include all learners due to be assessed from 1st September 2020 to 31st August 2021.

3. The VCRF is an evolution of the Extraordinary Regulatory Framework ('ERF'), which allowed qualifications to be awarded in spring and summer 2020 with adapted assessments or with Centre Assessed Grades ('CAGs'), and the Extended Extraordinary Regulatory Framework ('EERF'), which took effect at the start of the 2020-21 academic year and allows qualifications to be achieved with the adaption of assessments in line with the requirements set out by Awarding Organisations.

Learners Covered by this Document

4. This document outlines the processes that will be used for learners that would have been expected to be assessed between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021.
5. It is anticipated that the processes outlined in this document will not apply to learners that are to be assessed after 31st August 2021. This will be kept under review by regulators and should there be a change to this, Skills and Education Group Awards will inform Centres.
6. Where learners are on multi-year qualifications, it is allowable for elements that would have been assessed in the 2020-21 academic year to benefit from the approaches outlined in this document. However, the approaches in this document cannot be applied to assessments that were planned to be taken outside of the 2020-21 academic year.

Qualification Categories

7. All Skills and Education Group Awards qualifications fall into one of two categories under the VCRF:

Category A Qualifications

Qualifications in category A are more 'practical' qualifications, which involve the demonstration of a skill. These qualifications may act as evidence of professional competence or be designed to evidence a skill that may be used in the workplace.

Category B1 qualifications

These qualifications are most like GCSEs and A-Levels. Assessment need not continue, and TAGs may be awarded provided sufficient justification is available.
















Category B2 qualifications

These qualifications are not like General Qualifications, however their primary purpose of the qualification is for learners to progress onto further learning. These qualifications are not intended to demonstrate occupational competence or for the purpose of progression in the workplace, although there may be elements of practice or practical skill within the qualification. Category B2 qualifications may be awarded through the use of TAGs only where assessment cannot take place.

How is a TAG different from last year's CAGs?

A TAG must be based on assessment evidence generated by the learner(s) based on the knowledge, understanding or skills that would have been assessed in a 'normal' year. The evidence must be valid, reliable and authentic.

CAGs were estimated grades, showing what the learner(s) would most likely have achieved, had learning continued as normal.

The Awarding Approach

Category A Qualifications

8. Category A qualifications should be delivered and assessed as far as is possible. Where qualifications cannot be delivered or assessed under normal conditions, adaptations may be applied in line with the requirements set out by Skills and Education Group Awards. If it is not possible for a learner to complete the qualifications, even with the use of adaptations, assessment should be delayed until such a time that assessment can take place in line with public health requirements.

Summary:

- Assessment should continue as usual.

- If an assessment cannot be completed, adaptations may be applied for in line with Skills and Education Group Awards' requirements.
- If a learner cannot be assessed, even with adaptations, assessment must be delayed until safe and valid assessment can take place.

Category B1 Qualifications

9. Skills and Education Group Awards only has one 'B1' qualification: the Level 1 Award in Automotive Studies. For learners completing this qualification, it is envisaged that TAGs are the primary form of awarding.
10. Centres are advised to continue delivery, as far as it is safe to do so. However, if an assessment cannot be take, teachers may use TAGs to determine learner grades.
11. For the Level 1 Award in Automotive Studies, a minimum amount of evidence is required to justify TAGs – learners must have either completed the online synoptic assessment, or Centres must create a synoptic assessment of their own.

Summary:

- Assessment does not need to continue.
- A synoptic assessment must be completed – this can either be the online synoptic assessment, or Centres may devise an assessment of their own, however this should be pre-approved by Skills and Education Group Awards.

Category B2 Qualifications

12. As with Category A qualifications, content should be delivered and assessed as far as is possible. Where a qualification cannot be assessed under normal conditions, Centres may use adaptations in line with the requirements set by Skills and Education Group Awards. Where a qualification cannot be fully assessed, even with the use of adaptations, the qualification may be awarded using a Teacher Assessed Grade ('TAG').
13. It is the intent of the VCRF that TAGs are only used where they are the final remaining option in order for the learner to progress with their study. Centres should not proceed to using TAGs where they are able to undertake the assessment and where learners are able to be assessed.

Summary:

- Assessment should continue as usual.
- If an assessment cannot be completed, adaptations may be made in line with Skills and Education Group Awards' requirements.
- If it is not possible to assess the learner, even with use of further adaptations, the learner may be awarded a Teacher Assessed Grade, where sufficient evidence can be presented.

- If a learner cannot be assessed, even with adaptations, and there is not sufficient evidence to support a TAG, assessment must be delayed until safe and valid assessment can take place.

Making Adaptations

14. Some Skills and Education Group Awards qualifications allow the adaptation of assessment in order to allow learners to continue to be assessed through summer 2021.
15. It may be that not all providers are able to find and implement suitable adaptations for their qualifications.
16. It may also be that some qualifications listed by Ofqual as 'Category A' are not suitable for adaptations. One such example is the Level 2 Award in MOT Testing (Classes 4 and 7).
17. The majority of Skills and Education Group Awards' qualifications allow Centres to devise their own assessments. This allows Centres to set assessments that best meet the needs of their learners.
18. You may apply to adapt an assessment in advance using the 'Request for variation to assessment method' form.
19. In considering adaptations, we would encourage Centres to give consideration to how any adaptation or variation to assessment continues to give a valid result – i.e. ensures that the learner is still adequately assessed to ensure that the purpose of the qualification is met.
20. Skills and Education Group Awards will approve variation to assessment requests where the proposed adapted assessment ensures that the relevant assessment criteria continue to be met.
21. In some cases, it may not be possible for assessment criteria to be met through adaptation. Skills and Education Group Awards will approve adaptations where this is the case, providing the validity of the qualification is not affected. For instance, vital health and safety assessment tasks may not be amended if the assessment criteria cannot be met. However, for some tasks used towards an assessment criterion that says 'demonstrate', it may be acceptable for the learner to undertake a professional discussion with an assessor.
22. Variation to assessment requests will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. This is because some adaptations may not be available in all Centres and may not be suitable for all learners.

23. It is a requirement that all assessment criteria are met in order for the learner to achieve the qualification, therefore please do not attempt to adapt any assessment criterion itself.
24. The priority of Skills and Education Group Awards is to allow learners to complete their qualification as planned, without affecting the validity or perceived rigour of the qualification.
25. We will respond to all variation to assessment requests within 5 working days. If we do not approve the request, we will explain why.
26. Our '[Delivering and Assessing Qualifications](#)' publication may be useful in planning assessment activities. We publish a variety of templates on our Info Hub, which you may find useful.

Teacher Assessed Grades

27. Ofqual has published a guide for Centres on making objective judgements in reaching and agreeing TAGs. Centres are strongly advised to read this short guide:

28. In setting TAGs for B2 qualifications, learners should have been taught the full course of study and should be able to demonstrate the full range of knowledge, skills and understanding comparable to that expected for assessed work.
29. Special Considerations do not apply in the context of Centre-devised activities that are used to generate evidence for TAGs, such as mock exams, classwork or homework. Centres are advised to take into account the circumstances under which the learner has generated the evidence in determining their TAG to consider whether it may be appropriate to use alternative evidence, which may be more representative of a learner's performance.
30. An assessor cannot make a judgement for the award of a TAG on the basis of the potential of a learner. Judgments must be made based upon the evidence of what the student is able to do and not what they have the potential to achieve.
31. To ensure that results achieved through TAGs are valid and based on sufficient evidence, and to ensure continued stakeholder confidence in Skills and Education Group Awards qualifications, we will undertake Moderation activity and we will require Centres to make evidence supporting TAGs available to a Skills and Education Group Awards Moderator.
32. The following forms of evidence may all be used to justify TAGs:

- Individual assessments
- Partially completed internal assessments
- Classwork or homework assessments (including those from remote learning).
- Recordings (i.e. of a practical task being completed)
- Evidence from a work placement or work experience
- Mock examinations
- Witness testimonies
- Informal assessments
- Project work
- Tracker of achievement (this may not be used as evidence on its' own, and must be used alongside other evidence).

33. Unlike 2020, there are no Centre Assessed Grades or 'estimated' grades. Therefore previous performance is, in itself, not a form of evidence that can be used to justify a TAG. However, it may be that for graded units where other evidence to support the TAG is available, previous performance may be used to justify the final grade.

34. The evidence provided should cover the subject content that the learner has studied. If the learner has not undertaken any study related to a unit, they cannot receive a TAG for that unit. It is likely that there will be content in other units that can be cross-referenced to ensure coverage of much of the qualification. There is no restriction of the number of times a single piece of evidence can be used – if the evidence can relate to multiple units, it should be used.

35. The evidence used to justify a TAG must be in the form that it may be reviewed by others, such as written work or audio recordings.

How much of a qualification must a learner have achieved to qualify for Teacher Assessed Grades?

36. For B2 qualifications, we will expect that you make evidence available for each student for each unit you are using a TAG. You should have evidence to show each learning outcome has been delivered and has demonstrated the skills and knowledge in relation to each learning outcome. We do not expect that the entire curriculum (i.e. every assessment criterion) has been covered, but we require evidence to be available towards every learning outcome and unit within the qualification.

37. The evidence that you can present can be varied. We would encourage Centres to cross-reference similar tasks from other units in order to maximise the evidence you have available. We would also encourage the use recorded discussion with learners to fill gaps in your evidence.

38. The evidence you use for each earner should give a demonstration of what they are able to do, rather than a prediction or assumption about what they may be able to do.

Required content

39. Some qualifications will require that specific content must be covered in order for the qualification to be awarded. The following list will be updated through Spring and Summer 2021:

Qualification	Requirement
Level 1 Award in Automotive Studies	A synoptic assessment must have taken place in order to create sufficient evidence to justify the TAG. Centres may devise their own assessment, however it may be easier for learners to sit the online synoptic assessment.

Internal Quality Assurance of TAGs

40. Skills and Education Group Awards has not set a specific IQA process that Centres are required to follow. However, as a minimum, it is expected the following will have taken place:

- TAGs have been checked by a second member of appropriately experienced or qualified staff, to ensure they are accurate and reflect the achievement of that learner.
- The IQA process used is applied to all Skills and Education Group Awards provision at the Centre.
- The IQA process includes reference to historical achievement at the Centre and the Centre is assured that where there is a variance to historic achievement, the evidence presented does support the award of the TAGs claimed.

Informing us of Teacher Assessed Grades

41. Centres are required to inform Skills and Education Group Awards of TAGs no later than **Friday 18th June 2021** for the following qualifications:

- Level 1 Award in Automotive Studies
- Level 3 Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media
- Level 4 Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media

42. TAGs may be claimed for all other eligible qualifications until **Friday 13th August 2021**.

43. Centres wishing to claim TAGs must notify Skills and Education Group Awards in advance by submitting a Head of Centre Declaration to complianceandeducation@skillsedugroup.co.uk or email for further information.

44. When claiming TAGs, ORS users should proceed to the Results screen as usual. Where a result is related to a TAG Centres should enter an 'E' in front of the result as follows:

Merit (TAG)	EM	Only for graded units/qualifications
Distinction (TAG)	ED	Only for graded units/qualifications

How we will Quality Assure Teacher Assessed Grades?

45. Skills and Education Group Awards already have robust Quality Assurance practices in place, which we believe will enable us to use existing processes to ensure the quality of TAGs.

46. Where Centres have used TAGs, they are required to keep all of the evidence used to make that judgement. This will be checked at the next Moderation activity for that qualification. Evidence should be maintained for 6 months following the date of award.

47. It is the plan of Skills and Education Group Awards to undertake Moderation in as normal a manner as is possible over Spring and Summer 2021. Moderation may take place remotely, or may take place in a more 'normal' face-to-face manner as restrictions are lifted. Where Moderation activity cannot take place, evidence will be sampled at the next visit in that subject area. Please ensure all evidence relating to TAGs is available until Skills and Education Group Awards moderation has taken place.

48. As a part of our Quality Assurance Process, we will ensure that Internal Quality Assurance has been undertaken in a consistent and fair manner. If the Centre has produced a TAG or grading policy, we will ask to see this.

49. We will expect to see the following records as a minimum:

- Work from the learner used to justify the level the learner was working to, and therefore justify the TAG for that learner.

- IQA records showing that a rigorous process has been followed to ensure that the TAGs are objective and as far as possible free from bias.
- Evidence that the Centre has considered (where available) grade/results profiles from previous iterations of the qualification and that, if this differs from the profile of the TAGs, there is sufficient justification for the TAGs proposed by the Centre.

50. Ofqual have been clear in their guidance to Awarding Organisations that where TAGs are not underpinned by sufficient evidence, the Awarding Organisation should not award the qualification. Therefore where we find that TAGs are not underpinned by sufficient evidence, we will be unable to offer the award of that unit/qualification.

Reasonable Adjustments

51. Staff responsible for Special Educational Needs in their Centre must ensure that learners continue to receive the support for which they are eligible. Where a learner would have received a Reasonable Adjustment in normal circumstances, the Centre should ensure that the learner does receive that Reasonable Adjustment. This applies to assessment activity.

52. In line with Skills and Education Group Awards' Access to Assessment Policy, a record of all Reasonable Adjustments should be retained.

Head of Centre Declaration

53. Heads of Centre will be required to declare that:

- These grades have been checked for accuracy, reviewed by a second member of staff and are accurate and represent the professional judgements made by staff at the Centre.
- The Centre has met the requirements set out by Skills and Education Group Awards for internal quality assurance.
- They are satisfied that each student's grade is based on an appropriately broad range of evidence, and is their own work.
- Access arrangements and reasonable adjustments were provided with appropriate input from the SENCo and other specialists (and where they were not, that has been taken into account).
- Staff at the Centre have taken note of the guidance from exam boards about minimising bias, and are therefore confident that the judgements are fair.
- All relevant student evidence and records are available for inspection, as necessary.

54. We will be unable to process TAGs until such a time that a Head of Centre declaration has been received.

What should I do next? A Quick Summary...

Agree your internal process

- Where you have more than one tutor recommending TAGs, it is essential that all staff at your Centre are consistent – especially with learners undertaking the same or similar qualifications.

Continue delivering and, as far as possible, assessing

- TAGs are an available option where delivery and assessment cannot take place; it is the expectation that TAGs are not the 'normal' method of awarding as was the case with 'CAGs' in summer 2020.
- As we will expect evidence to be available for all units, try to ensure that the full breadth of the curriculum is covered, even if you cannot go into the detail you normally would.

Gather evidence

- Consider the purpose of the qualification – has the learner met the qualification purpose?
- Consider how to maximise the evidence you have – can a piece of evidence be used for several units? Could a 'viva' or discussion with the learner fill any 'gaps' in the evidence available?
- You should be assured that there is an evidence base available to demonstrate that the learner has demonstrated they have the knowledge and skills required for each learning outcome.

Suggest a grade for each student and unit that you are using TAGs

- Suggest a grade, based on the evidence you have available.

Discuss your suggested grades with Colleagues

- Ensure your IQA process is consistent across your Centre and that decisions made by different tutors in similar subject areas are comparable.

Submit the Grades to Skills and Education Group Awards

- See paragraph 37-40 of this guide for instructions.

Await information regarding Moderation

- We will be in touch once we have received your TAGs. If evidence is not available for Moderation, we are unable to award TAGs.
