Gateway Requirements

From August 2022 people who start a Level 2 apprenticeship without Level 1 English and maths will no longer need to automatically attempt Level 2 English and Maths tests to complete their apprenticeship.

The Assessment

The apprentice will be assessed against the Sewing Machinist Assessment Plan requirements. The three methods of assessment are:

- · Practical skills test
- Observation in the workplace
- Interview underpinned by portfolio of evidence
