Gateway Requirements

Apprentices will need to achieve Level 2 English and mathematics prior to undertaking their End-Point Assessment.

The Assessment

The Apprentice will be assessed against the Bespoke Tailor and Cutter Assessment Plan requirements. The three methods of assessment are:

- Final Project
- Professional Presentation and Discussion
- Textiles Assignment Research Project
