About the End-Point Assessment

Sewing machinists use industrial sewing machines, which may be supported by hand sewing techniques. They use techniques such as lock stitching, blind hemming, cover stitch, cup seaming, ruffling, and linking. They complete quality checks, prepare materials for the next stage in the process and complete work records. Conducting basic sewing machine maintenance is also part of the role. They also contribute to maintaining the work area and improvement work.

Sewn products may include aviation textiles, clothing, leather goods, marine textiles, medical textiles, and soft furnishings.

Companies who employ sewing machinists may be large, small, or micro-sized. They may specialise in certain sewn products, or the sewn product may be part of a wider manufacturing process.
