The standard has two specialisms: transport supervisor, ensuring the safe and compliant utilisation of all drivers and equipment, and warehouse supervisor, ensuring the provision of a professional incoming goods, storage and dispatch service to customers.

Gateway Requirements

Where applicable, in line with funding rules, apprentices must have achieved English and maths at Level 2.

Apprentices on the transport option must have achieved one of the two following qualifications:

- Level 3 Certificate of Professional Competence for Transport Managers (Road Haulage)
- Ministry of Defence: Junior Transport Operator L3

Typical duration to Gateway: 12 months.

The Assessment

The apprentice will be assessed against the Transport and Warehouse Operations Supervisor requirements.

The methods of assessment are:

- Multiple-choice test
- Project report with presentation and questioning
- Interview
