Level 2 Certificate in Manufacturing Textile Products (NVQ) (501/0173/0)

#### **Key Features**

The qualification will enable learners to develop the knowledge and skills required for work in the textiles manufacturing sector.

The qualification has been designed in response to an identified industry need for specific programmes of learning within the textiles manufacturing sector, is mapped to the most recent National Occupational Standards and it is included in the Fashion and Textiles Apprenticeship Framework.

Candidates will gain insight into core activities such as Health, safety and security at work, How to maintain the quality of production working with textiles, leather and materials and more within the textiles manufacturing industry.

The qualification will prepare learners for progression to the Level 3 qualifications within this sector, into employment and/or further education and training.

The qualification is regulated by Ofqual.

These qualifications are designed for young people aged 16+ who are looking for a vocational qualification for progression into further education or employment.
