SEG Awards Entry 3 Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies (600/6105/4)

The SEG Awards Entry Level Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies is part of the SEG Awards Entry Level suite which offers learners practical experience and knowledge of the automotive sector to support engagement, participation, achievement and progression for learners at Entry Level, ideally through the full subject suite and beyond. The overall aim is to provide both experience and knowledge on which to base future career and associated progression decisions for further learning.

This qualification forms part of SEG Awards Foundation Learning offer in the Engineering and Manufacturing Technologies sector.

What does this qualification cover?

To achieve the Entry Level Diploma learners have to achieve a total of 19 credits from the Mandatory group and a further 18 credits must come from Optional group.

- Principles of engine components and operations
- Check and maintain vehicle fluid levels
- Check and maintain motor vehicle external lights
- Checking and maintaining car tyre pressure and tread
- Remove and replace motor vehicle road wheels
- Motorcycle construction
- Routine motorcycle checks
- Routine braking system checks
- Routine vehicle checks
- Clean a vehicle exterior and interior

- Introduction to vehicle ignition systems

Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

This qualification is designed for young people aged 14+ and adults who have an interest in the automotive sector as an area of employment and want to develop practical skills in this subject

There are no formal entry requirements onto the Entry Level 3 Diploma.

What could this qualification lead to?

Will the qualification lead to employment, and if so, in which iob role at which level?

Successful completion of the Entry Level 3 Diploma will not lead directly into employment but provides a sound preparation for further vocational training and provides both experience and knowledge on which to base future career and associated progression decisions.

Will the qualification support progression to further learning, if so, what to?

This qualification sits within Foundation Learning and is suitable for learners' pre and post 16 who are engaged in a personalised learning programme. Learners could progress from the SEG Awards Entry Level 3 Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies to the ABC Level 1 Award/Certificate/Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies



and then onto a Level 2 automotive qualification such as the SEG Awards Level 2 Award, Certificate or Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies, or onto an Apprenticeship(Level 2).

If there are larger and/or smaller versions of this qualification at the same Level, why should a learner take this particular one?

The Entry 3 Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies is part of a larger suite of Motor Vehicle Studies qualifications:

- Entry Level Award in Motor Vehicle Studies (Entry 3)
- Entry Level Certificate in Motor Vehicle Studies (Entry 3)
- Entry Level Diploma in Motor Vehicle Studies (Entry 3)

The Diploma provides learners who especially have limited qualifications in this area, to make bite sized developmental progression at Entry Level. The Diploma has additional units in the mandatory group to those offered in the Certificate. The Diploma learner will have an extended and more comprehensive learning package than that covered by the Certificate.

It is hoped that learners who successfully complete this qualification can move forward with increased confidence into further training.
