SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Small Animal Care and Welfare – 610/3425/3

Overview

The SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Small Animal Care and Welfare has been designed to develop knowledge and skills within care and welfare for small animals.

Who is this qualification for?

The SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Small Animal Care and Welfare is designed for learners of the age of 16 and over, who are currently working with small animals or planning to in the future. This qualification will allow learners to formalise their learning, especially if they are looking after small animals in any capacity.

There are no entry requirements for this qualification however, it is expected for Learners to have working knowledge of at least level 2.

What does the qualification cover?

The SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Small Animal Care and Welfare has been designed to provide learners with an introduction to the care and welfare of small animals.

The qualification covers:

- Small Animal First Aid - In this unit, Learners will examine the reasons for and rules around the provision of first aid to small animals, looking at different types of emergency situations and how to deal with these if they occur.
- The Need of Small Animals - Learners will know how to correctly ensure welfare is upheld and why it is an important part of small animal care. This unit will explore the necessary health and welfare measures to take when looking after small animals, along with governing legislation.

What could this qualification lead to?

Learners may progress on to further studies within Animal Care or even employment in roles such as pet boarding, pet shops or small animal rescues.

Learners could also look to progress within various other regulated qualifications within the Animal Care sector that Skills and Education Group Awards offers, to expand on their knowledge and experience in animal care further.
