Who is this qualification for?

The SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Aquatic Treadmill Therapy for Small Animals is designed for Learners who are interested in the welfare of animals and who have previous experience working alongside them.

Learners will need to be of the age of 16 and over, and have obtained a Level 3 Qualification in Small Animal Hydrotherapy not including aquatic units within the qualification.

What does the qualification cover?

The SEG Awards Level 3 Award in Aquatic Treadmill Therapy for Small Animals has been designed to provide learners with fundamental information in the section of small animal hydrotherapy. The aim of this qualification includes the chance for the learners to manage and work on aquatic treadmills and evaluate the animals whilst using the equipment. The learners will develop a plan for treadmill sessions and work alongside versatile professionals.

The qualification covers:

- Practical Aquatic Treadmill Treatment - The objective of this unit is to equip learners with practical skills in utilising the aquatic treadmill. They will gain knowledge to comprehend factors influencing patients in the aquatic treadmill, enabling them to assess small animal patients for suitability and formulate a treatment plan.

What could this qualification lead to?

Learners may progress into the Level 3 Award in Advanced Aquatic Treadmill Therapy. All assessment methods used throughout delivering this qualification must be reliable, fair and safe for all learners to participate in.
